For students from Belgium, Denmark, Norway, and ITEA Spain, please check the exclusions in their insurance handbook.*

Prohibited Dangerous Activities

- **Driving or riding as a passenger on/in a recreational vehicle:** This includes, but is not limited to, jet-skis, ATVs, motocross bikes, scooters, and snowmobiles.
- **Boxing**
- **Bungee jumping**
- **Scuba Diving**
- **Skydiving**
- **Rock climbing:** Indoor and outdoor
- **Hang gliding**
- **Parachuting**
- **Zip lining**
- **Para-sailing**
- **Horseback riding**
- **Skiing**
- **Skateboarding**
- **Snowboarding**
- **Windsurfing**
- **Spelunking**

Perilous Activity: Flying

Flying is considered a perilous activity and is strictly prohibited, except:

- As a passenger on a regularly scheduled airline;
- As a passenger on a chartered carrier for purposes of an approved grant program activity, or;
- As a passenger in the Military Airlift Command of the U.S. or similar air transport services of other countries.
