Prior to participating in dangerous activities, students must provide this form signed by the student, natural parent(s) and host parent(s). In some cases students must be licensed or certified in the activity and / or provide proof of supplemental liability insurance. See the "Dangerous Activities Descriptions" document for more info.

Students are expected to take adequate safety precautions and follow all local laws when participating in any kind of physical activity (i.e. helmets may be required when riding a bicycle, life jackets are required when boating, etc.). Choosing to participate in a dangerous activity that is prohibited could lead to YFU ending a student's program and / or lack of insurance coverage for medical bills that result from an accident.

If you are unsure if an activity is or should be considered dangerous or if you are considering an activity not listed here, contact your Support Services Manager for verification.
